Dear Dr. Maxey,

Greetings in Jesus' Powerful and Matchless Name.

In response to your request for a report on my WATS visit, I submit the following to you. First, I want to thank Dr. Oliver Ngwuli for suggesting to me to contact you regarding WATS. I thank you very much for approving my request and extending the invitation for me to come and visit. I counted it an honor.

I was totally impressed by the love, respect, courtesy, friendship, and acceptance accorded to me by everyone - the Provost/President - Dr. Dauda Gava, the Protocol Host - Rev. Emmanuel, the Driver- Edet, the Executive Board, the Director of Missions - Dr. Felicia Priest, the Director of the Doctoral program - Dr. Victor Priest, Happy Gava - the Provost daughter, the Manager/Cook of the guest house - Johnson, the security - Anton and others, the Discipleship pastor - Rev. Gary Samuelson, and the students. It was indeed divine as Christlikeness was exemplified.

I arrived on Wednesday afternoon and was picked up at the airport by Rev. Emmanuel, the protocol host, and Edet, the driver. I was taken to the WATS guest house and was immediately served dinner by Johnson, the cook. Dr. Gava came over and introduced himself. He later introduced me to Happy Gava, his happy daughter, who immediately reminded me of my three daughters.

Dr. Gava officially invited me to his office on Thursday morning and he told me a bit about himself and a brief history of WATS. I was then introduced to the Executive board and each one described his role. I was then given the opportunity to introduce myself after which I presented Dr. Gava with an autographed copy of my book *Blind faith - My Life*. We were all photographed and then I was taken to the office of the Director of the Doctor of Ministry Program where I met Dr. Victor Priest Chukwuma and he presented me with an autographed copy of his book *Occupational Stress in Christian Institutions of Higher Education*. I also presented him with an autographed copy of my

book, *Blind Faith - My Life* and took pictures with him and his wife, Dr. Felicia Priest Chukwuma.

I was then taken on a tour of the seminary. I saw the classrooms, the library, The bookstore- ACTS, the Centre of Wisdom, the Chapel, and the Clinic. The boys' and girls' dorms were pointed out including various offices. I was introduced to the medical staff - the nurses and the doctor. I was told that a mother had just given birth to a baby girl, and I prayed for her baby. I was also told that another mother was waiting to give birth.

When I got back to the guest house, I could hardly sleep that night. God was nudging me and telling me that I had to return to the clinic the next day, and that I should give my name (Junegrid) to the baby. I reached out to the Director of Missions, Dr. Felicia and she took me back to the clinic on Friday after chapel. When I got there I was told that the mother who had given birth the day before was discharged, but that another mom had just given birth to a baby girl. When I saw the baby, I felt prompted that that was the baby to whom God wanted me to give my name and I asked the mom if she had a name for her baby. She was not certain, so I told her that God sent me on a mission, and I asked her if I had her permission to give her baby my name.

I gave her the history of my name, stating that my oldest sister is called Ingrid, my next sister is called Maygrid because she was born on May 3rd, and I surprised my mother who thought that I was going to be born in June. I came 3 days earlier on May 29, and she called me Junegrid. I explained that my name means "Summer Life." The baby's mom smiled and complied with a nodding gesture, and everyone in the room was elated. I held the baby, prayed for her, blessed her, and dedicated her to the Lord. I then felt led by God to give her \$10 representing the two-rainbowed hands logo of my Ministry "This Is What Jesus Will Do Ministries - The Five-Fold Ministry of the five fingers, and Five of the fruit of the Spirit of the next five fingers.

After I returned to the guest house Doctor Adedorin texted me and said that a miracle took place. He explained that the baby was previously diagnosed with duodenal atresia congenital disease. At the same time, James, the baby's father texted me that a prophetess from his church told him and his wife to go to WATS clinic and they would meet with God there. Doctor Adedorin stated that when he did the scan test on the baby after I prayed for her, there was no trace of that fatal congenital disease. God did a miracle in an unorthodox way. The father also reported that while I was in the room praying for his baby, he was in the bathroom crying because he needed \$10 to pay for an injection that his baby needed. When he came out and was told that I gave his baby \$10 he was crying for joy because it was the exact amount that he needed and God provided. Praise God!

After the tour of the classrooms and the library, I felt burdened and uncomfortable in my spirit. I was sensitized to the leading of the Holy Spirit and I

emailed the provost, Dr. Gava and the Missions Director, Dr. Felicia the following correspondence:

“Dear Dr. Gava/Dr. Felicia

It was an honor to meet with you and the Board of Directors of WATS this morning. Thank you very much for the exciting and informative tour of the WATS campus. Congratulations on the incredible work that you and your staff are doing in providing leadership training for the students. I am very impressed with all the departments that I saw, and I know that greater things are yet to come.

The library impacted me tremendously. Without meaning to be presumptuous, I believe that a large part of your vision is the digitization of the WATS library, with the intention to transform it from the traditional model and unlock new potential for the students through technology.

As a servant of God who operates in "Blind Faith, " and as the Founder and CEO of "This Is What Jesus Will Do Ministries Inc," I will confer with my Board of Directors at our next meeting to commit to provide the WATS library with computers as the Lord directs us.

I look forward to conferring with you further on this matter. Thank you.”

Dr. Felicia recently asked me to consider some computers for the mission’s department, and I complied. I appreciate your fervent prayers as I proceed with this step of faith to secure computers for the library and the mission’s department.

After dinner on Friday night, I was directed by God to request from Dr. Gava and Dr. Felicia an impromptu Saturday outreach. They promptly agreed and the Saturday outreach became a reality as Dr. Victor and his wife spearheaded that mission. I was impressed by the joy and excitement by the members of the outreach team as they enthusiastically ministered in song and the preached-Word of God. I also was given the opportunity by Dr. Felicia and her husband to minister. God used me to preach the Word and pray for two young men, and I led them in the prayer of repentance for salvation.

On Sunday I went to church with Pastor Victor Priest and his wife at the New Beginnings International Church (NBIC). I had the privilege of praying the benediction over Pastors Victor and Felicia, and their congregation.

“Benediction 9/22/2024

Ephesians 1:17 -19

I bless Pastor Dr. Victor Priest Chukwuma, his wife Pastor Dr. Felicia Priest Chukwuma, and the congregation of New Beginnings International Church in the Name of Jesus. I pray that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of Glory, may give to you the Spirit of Wisdom and Revelation in the Knowledge of Him, that the eyes of your understanding be

enlightened; that you may know what is the Hope of His Calling, what are the Riches of the Glory of His inheritance in the Saints, and what *is* the Exceeding Greatness of His Power toward you who believe.

Colossians 1:9-12

I bless Pastor Dr. Victor Priest Chukwuma, his wife Pastor Dr. Felicia Priest Chukwuma, and the congregation of New Beginnings International Church in the Name of Jesus. I pray for you, and ask God to fill you with the knowledge of His Will in all Wisdom and Spiritual understanding; that you may walk worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing Him, being fruitful in every good work and increasing in the Knowledge of God; strengthened with all might, according to His Glorious Power, for all patience and longsuffering with joy; giving thanks to the Father who has qualified you to be partakers of the inheritance of the Saints in the light.”

I included the children and the young people in the benediction and declared prophetically that NBIC would be a launching pad for many to come, receive, and be refreshed, so that they can go to refresh others.” We were then invited to Elder Tunde’s home and we prayed for him and his household, including his helper. We had lunch at Pastors Victor’s and Felicia’s home, and a prophetic Word was spoken into their lives. I ministered at Chapel on Monday on the theme “Christlikeness.” My subtheme was “Christlikeness-Spirit Empowerment=Go. I emphasized that we are righteous/holy/Christlike because Christ has Spirit-Empowered us to be so, and because we are Spirit empowered, we are mandated to go into the whole world and preach the Gospel. I challenged the students to employ five D’s as they pursue and exemplify Christlikeness. 1. Declare that they are Christlike 2. Decide to be Christlike 3. Dig deep into the Word of God to be Christlike 4. Dominate the flesh and every temptation to be Christlike 5. Deconstruct false teaching to be Christlike. At the end I gave out 20 evangelism booklets to the students, asked them to read it first and then share it with someone who needs salvation. The booklet is called *This New Life* by BillyJoe Daugherty, the deceased father of my pastor, Paul Daugherty. I also gave out some of my ministry cards and brochures and encouraged students to keep in touch with me. I prayed the following benediction over the students and WATS at the end.

I pray that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of Glory, may give to you the Spirit of Wisdom and Revelation in the Knowledge of Him, that the eyes of your understanding be enlightened; that you may know what is the Hope of His Calling, what are the Riches of the Glory of His inheritance in the Saints, and what *is* the Exceeding Greatness of His Power toward you who believe.

Colossians 1:9-12

I bless the students, administrators, and staff of WATS in the Name of Jesus. I pray for you, and ask God to fill you with the knowledge of His Will in all Wisdom and Spiritual understanding; that you may walk worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing Him, being fruitful in every good work and increasing in the Knowledge of God; strengthened with all might, according to His Glorious Power, for all patience and longsuffering with joy; giving thanks to the Father who has qualified you to be partakers of the inheritance of the Saints in the light."

I requested to tour the seminary again, and on Tuesday morning Dr. Felicia communicated with Rev. Gary Samuelson and he took me to the ACTS bookstore, the classes that were in progress, and the professors' offices. I also visited Dr. Gary's office. He shared with me of an upcoming conference next year and indicated that he would like me to minister. I told him I will pray about it because I only go where and when God sends me. Rev. Gary also gave me a close-up view of the WATS bus.

I visited the clinic again to see Baby Junegrid. She had just returned from getting her immunization shots and was asleep. I took photos with the parents, James and Abigail, and prayed for them and their baby. Doctor Adedorin spoke to me in person about Baby Junegrid's miracle and said that he decided to put the miracle on the seminary platform. Dr. Adedorin also shared that his desire is to attend to emergency cases in people's homes especially when a woman is in labor in the middle of the night, and she needs a cesarean section. He explained that his previous car was stolen, and that he needed another car to help him fulfill that mission. I felt led by the lord to tell him that he should ask God to direct him to the Best car that God has for him to fulfill the call of God in his life, and to share the details with me. I will express this need to the Board of Directors of my ministry, and we anticipate God's blessings.

Dr. Gary invited me to attend his Discipleship class and I waited in the Adjunct professor's room until it was time to do so. The Discipleship class was interactive and very interesting. Rev. Gary asked me to pray for the students corporately at the end. I prayed for them to fulfill the mandate of the Great Commission in their lives. During the afternoon, Happy Gava offered to take me to the marketplace to get some Nigerian souvenirs-bracelets, and some beautiful Nigerian outfits. She was patient with me and did an excellent job. The walk was indeed a necessary physical exercise for me.

Rev. Emmanuel, the Protocol Host and Edet, the driver, came for me at 7: 00 a.m on Wednesday to take me to the airport. After spending about 2 hours in the air the pilot said we had to return to the airport because a passenger forgot her child's medical instrument in the airport. We were told that just the child's mother and the family members would evacuate the plane, and the other passengers would remain on the plane. The pilot emphasized that there would be firefighters on spot in case of any fires since there was more fuel on the plane than there was supposed to be. I told the flight

attendant that I felt in my spirit that we should all evacuate. I asked her to tell the pilot that we should all be proactive and evacuate, and not wait for something to happen and then try to evacuate. The pilot had us all evacuate and we were put up in a hotel since the flight was eventually canceled.

At 1:00 a.m. on Thursday, God told me that I could no longer remain silent about the miracle that He did with Baby Junegrid. He lovingly reprimanded me and told me that I had to record the miraculous occurrence and send it to prayer intercessors for them to pray, since the devil had targeted me on the plane. God impressed upon me that I could be responsible for the lives of the passengers if I did not comply. God referred me to Revelation 12:11 and told me that I can overcome by the Blood of the Lamb and the Word of my testimony, and I love not my life unto death. I obeyed God and recorded Baby Junegrid's healing testimony. I sent it out and the prayer support started coming in. We left the airport at 10:30 a.m. on Thursday, and by 1:00 a.m. on Friday I was home. Praise God. Hallelujah.
